

#### **CHILD LIFE**

Developmental, social, and emotional support for children of all ages, delivered through therapeutic play, distraction, and creative arts by experienced Child Life Specialists



#### **SOCIAL WORK**

Assistance to children and families, including access to transportation, financial assistance, and social and psychological support, provided by trained social workers



#### **BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**

Access to assessments, therapeutic intervention, and behavioral health services integrated with a child's medical care and provided by licensed behavioral health specialists

## A COMPREHENSIVE CHILD LIFE PROGRAM

### When a child is admitted to the hospital, suddenly their world is anything but normal.


They cannot run or play outdoors, attend school, or even sleep in the comfort of their own bed. But a dedicated Child Life Specialist can make a clinical environment feel a little more like home. Serving children from infancy to adolescence as well as their parents, a Child Life Department is an essential pillar of a modern, high-quality pediatric hospital.

Child Life Specialists engage kids and families in activities that encourage healthy coping methods and foster a sense of normalcy. They also utilize therapeutic play and distraction to soothe patients before, during, and after procedures. For minor procedures, therapeutic distraction can sometimes replace the need for sedation altogether, leading to a smoother and more comfortable recovery.

Abundant research has shown that Child Life Specialists help children find strength, accelerate their healing, and empower them to become their healthiest, happiest selves. Even so, Child Life is non-reimbursable by insurance and operates within a fixed budget.

### ACCESS TO PEDIATRIC CLINICAL SOCIAL WORK

### The demands of everyday life do not pause when a child needs medical care.

Often, an unexpected medical situation may impede a family's ability to meet their basic needs, resulting in unique challenges that only an experienced social worker can address.

A child could receive exceptional medical care, but their ability to thrive is also impacted by factors such as their home environment, family dynamic, school environment, and psychosocial wellness. Social workers provide immediate and long-term support to address challenges across all aspects of family life, helping achieve better health and well-being for patients, siblings, and their parents and caregivers.

In addition to providing counseling, discharge planning, advocacy, education, and support specific to a child's diagnosis, social workers can connect families to assistance programs helping reduce the financial burdens that arise during a child's hospital stay.

### In Pittsburgh alone, UPMC Children's Clinical Social Work team:

- Serves tens of thousands of children and families across our main hospital, Emergency Department, and outpatient clinics
- Provides vital transportation assistance to families
- Offers 24/7 access to social services in the inpatient setting



Access to Clinical Social Work is a lifeline for families. Providing 24/7 access to social services empowers our hospital to help families mitigate challenges before they escalate into crises.

Non-medical financial challenges families commonly face include access to transportation, maintaining job security with unexpected hospital stays, and keeping up with household bills. When access to a licensed social worker is integrated into a child's care, a family's most urgent challenge can be addressed before it escalates into an emergency.

Clinical Social Work is a non-reimbursable service, but it is essential to promoting the well-being of children and families.

## INTEGRATED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

At UPMC Children's, we strive to equalize the importance of a child's physical health and behavioral health.

A medical event or diagnosis can have a significant impact on a child's behavioral health and mental and emotional well-being. Fueled by philanthropy, UPMC Children's has prioritized the seamless integration of behavioral health services into a child's medical care in Pittsburgh.

At our main hospital, licensed psychologists within UPMC Children's Behavioral Science Division are embedded in subspecialty areas, where they provide dedicated support to children and families based on a child's diagnosis — including type 1 diabetes, cystic fibrosis, traumatic brain injuries, and beyond. Psychologists address a wide range of cognitive, emotional, and behavioral challenges, and they provide treatment through education, supportive psychotherapy, relaxation training, cognitive behavioral therapy, and psychopharmacology.

Behavioral health services are also accessible in UPMC Children's Community Pediatrics (CCP) practices, where staff have experience providing therapies for challenges such as anxiety, depression, mood disorders, and loss and grief.



Philanthropy empowers behavioral health specialists at UPMC Children's to respond nimbly to the most urgent needs of the children and families they serve.

Donor support has also empowered UPMC Children's to identify and address the unique behavioral health needs of young people in Pittsburgh through services such as the Behavioral Health Walk-In Clinic. Located in our main hospital and open on evenings and weekends, this clinic is a safe space for children needing one-time, non-emergency interventions for mental health concerns such as anxiety, anger, and depression.
